## Did You Know!

Three million people in Pennsylvania rely on a private water well or spring for their drinking water but we are one of the few states that lack statewide regulations on the location, construction or maintenance of these water supplies. Most water wells have never been properly tested and Penn State research has shown that 40% fail at least one drinking water standard.
