Pine Hill Water District

The Pine Hill Water District was taken over by the Town after the private water company that was operating it essentially abandoned the system. Needed improvements included a water source rehabilitation, new storage, and new distribution system.

RCAP Solutions assisted the town to:

- Secure \$1.5 million in DWSRF and RD funding for a drinking water system upgrade,
- Secure engineering services,
- Manage the project budget and provide documentation to funders,
- Conduct a rate structure evaluation, and
- Coordinate with primacy agencies and funders.
